On behalf of the UniFirst Corporation, GEI Consultants, Inc. collected a soil gas sample from beneath your basement slab at 154 Glen Street on February 28, 2007. We appreciate your cooperation in helping us to arrange this sampling.

The laboratory testing did not detect tetrachloroethylene (PCE) or other chlorinated volatile organic compounds (VOCs) at a concentration above the laboratory reporting limits. We have attached the laboratory data sheet reporting the results of the sub-slab soil gas test. We have also included a "Notice of Environmental Sampling Form (BWSC-123)" required by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP).

Since VOCs were not detected above the laboratory reporting limits in the sub-slab soil gas beneath your basement slab, we will not be scheduling any work inside your home at this time. However, we request your cooperation to conduct an additional sample of the sub-slab soil gas during the summer of 2007 to confirm these results. We will contact you in July to make those arrangements.

Re: Soil Gas Sampling Results 23 Knowlton Street Somerville, Massachusetts

On behalf of the UniFirst Corporation, GEI Consultants, Inc. collected a soil gas sample from beneath your basement slab at 31 Knowlton Street on February 28, 2007. We appreciate your cooperation in helping us to arrange this sampling.

The laboratory detected the chlorinated volatile organic compounds (VOCs) tetrachloroethylene (PCE) at a concentration of 0.61 parts per billion by volume (ppbv) (4.1 micrograms per cubic meter ($\mu g/m^3$)), and 1,1,1-trichloroethane at a concentration of 0.26 ppbv (1.4 $\mu g/m^3$). We have attached the laboratory data sheet of the soil gas sample. We have also included a "Notice of Environmental Sampling Form (BWSC-123)" required by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP).

Although these soil gas concentrations are below the threshold concentration of 10 ug/m3, we would like to conduct confirmatory testing of indoor air in your home. We will collect two samples of indoor air over a 4-hour time period, one sample from your basement area and one from the first floor area. After laboratory testing of the air samples is complete we will send the results of the assessment to you.

If the results of the indoor air sampling indicate VOCs are not detected or are at concentrations below that which the DEP has said are a threshold limit for significant risk to human health, we will request your cooperation to conduct an additional three rounds of sampling over the next year to confirm those results. However, if the concentrations of VOCs are above what the DEP has said are threshold limits for significant risk of harm to health and the levels it typically finds in homes, we will recommend installing a sub-slab depressurization system, as described in our letter of March 5, 2007.

We will contact you in the next few days to arrange indoor air sampling. We appreciate your cooperation throughout the sampling process. If you have any immediate questions regarding the



On behalf of the UniFirst Corporation, GEI Consultants, Inc. collected a soil gas sample from beneath your basement slab at 31 Knowlton Street on March 5, 2007. We appreciate your cooperation in helping us to arrange this sampling.

The laboratory detected the chlorinated volatile organic compound (VOC) tetrachloroethylene (PCE) at a concentration of 0.39 parts per billion by volume (ppbv) (2.6 micrograms per cubic meter ($\mu g/m^3$)). We have attached the laboratory data sheet reporting the results of the sub-slab soil gas test. We have also included a "Notice of Environmental Sampling Form (BWSC-123) required by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP).

In addition to the soil gas samling that we conducted in March, GEI conducted indoor air testing in your home on January 22, 2007. GEI measured 0.44 ppbv $(3.0 \,\mu\text{g/m}^3)$ of PCE in your basement. PCE was not detected above laboratory reporting limits in the sample collected from the first floor. The PCE concentration detected in your home is below what DEP has said is the threshold limit for significant risk of harm to health over a short period of time and below the level it typically finds in homes.

We would like to conduct confirmatory testing of indoor air in your home. We will collect two samples of indoor air over a 4-hour time period, one sample from your basement area and one from the first floor area. After laboratory testing of the air samples is complete we will send the results of the assessment to you.

If the results of the indoor air sampling continue to indicate VOCs are not detected or are at concentrations below that which the DEP has said are a threshold limit for significant risk to human health, we will request your cooperation to conduct an additional two rounds of sampling over the next year to confirm those results. However, if the concentrations of VOCs are above what the DEP has said are threshold limits for significant risk of harm to health and the levels it typically finds in homes, we will recommend installing a sub-slab depressurization system, as described in our letter of March 5, 2007.

On behalf of the UniFirst Corporation, GEI Consultants, Inc. collected a soil gas sample from beneath your basement slab at 95R Franklin Street on March 21, 2007. We appreciate your cooperation in helping us to arrange this sampling.

The laboratory detected the chlorinated volatile organic compounds (VOCs) tetrachloroethylene (PCE) at a concentration of 15,900 parts per billion by volume (ppbv) (108,000 micrograms per cubic meter (μ g/m³)), trichloroethylene (TCE) at 924 ppbv (4,970 μ g/m³), 1,1,1-trichloroethane at 239 ppbv (1,300 μ g/m³), 1,1-dichloroethylene at 235 ppbv (932 μ g/m³), 1,1-dichloroethane at 196 ppbv (793 μ g/m³), and cis-1,2-dichloroethylene at a concentration of 127 ppbv (504 μ g/m³). We have attached the laboratory data sheet reporting the results of the sub-slab soil gas test. We have also included a "Notice of Environmental Sampling Form (BWSC-123)" required by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP).

Based on the results of testing of the soil gas beneath your basement slab, we recommend installing a sub-slab depressurization system in your home, as described in our letter of March 5, 2007. We will install the SSDS at not cost to you. The SSDS will be a permanent remedy to prevent the VOCs from infiltrating into your home.

In the interim, as we make arrangements for installing the SSDS, we will install a temporary portable air purifier in your basement. We will reimburse you for the cost of electricity required to run the air purifier. The air purifier is a relatively small portable unit, similar to those sold by stores such as Brookstone and the Sharper Image. Literature describing the air purifier is enclosed.

We will contact you in the next few days to provide you an air purifier and arrange for the installation of the SSDS. We appreciate your cooperation throughout the sampling process. If

On behalf of the UniFirst Corporation, GEI Consultants, Inc. conducted soil gas and groundwater sampling in the parking lot of the American Legion Post located at 163 Glen Street, as part of our investigation related to the site at 50 Tufts Street in Somerville, Massachusetts. We appreciate your cooperation while we collected soil gas samples on February 19, 2007, and groundwater samples on February 20, 2007.

The laboratory did not report detections of any chlorinated volatile organic compounds (VOCs) above the laboratory reporting limits in the sample collected from the monitoring well in the American Legion parking lot (MW113). We have attached a summary table of the results and the laboratory data sheet of the groundwater sample collected from MW113. We have also included a "Notice of Environmental Sampling Form (BWSC-123)" required by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP).

In addition to testing the groundwater, we collected a soil gas sample for laboratory testing of VOCs from MW113. The laboratory detected 2.0 parts per billion by volume (ppbV) of 1,1-dichloroethane, 5.2 ppbV 1,1-dichloroethylene, 2 ppbV of 1,1,1-trichloroethane, and 3 ppbV of trichloroethylene (TCE) in the soil gas sample. We expect to repeat groundwater and soil gas sampling of MW113 to confirm these results in April of 2007.

(GEI) conducted indoor air sampling in your buildings located at 32 and 40 Alston Street in February 2007 as part of our investigation, on behalf of the UniFirst Corporation, related to the site at 50 Tufts Street in Somerville, Massachusetts. We appreciate your cooperation while we collected indoor air samples on February 14, 2007.

We have attached a summary table of the results and the laboratory data sheets of each indoor air sample collected at your property. We have also included a "Notice of Environmental Sampling Form (BWSC-123)" required by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP).

GEI's testing measured 1.1 parts per billion by volume (ppbv) of tetrachloroethylene (PCE) in the indoor air at 32 Alston Street, and 0.63 ppbv of PCE in the indoor air at 40 Alston Street. The PCE concentration detected in your home is below the threshold limit, based on DEP's policies and procedures, for determining significant risk of harm to health over a short period of time in homes.

In addition to testing the indoor air in your buildings, we collected groundwater and soil gas samples on Alston Street. Chlorinated VOCs were detected above laboratory reporting limits in the soil gas samples. Based on the results of our testing, we would like to take measures to prevent chlorinated volatile organic compounds (VOCs) from infiltrating into the indoor air of your building.

To that end, we have already received your cooperation for the following tasks:

- An engineer from GEI performed a detailed observation of your building on March 6, 2007. We collected information about the foundation, including the type and condition of the foundation. We also collected information on your building's heating and cooling system.
- GEI installed six sub-slab monitoring points at inconspicuous locations in the foundation slab. These were installed by drilling a small hole (3/4 inch diameter) through the foundation slab and inserting tubing. On March 8 we measured the pressure beneath the slab and collected a sample of the soil gas from beneath the slab for laboratory testing. A picture of what this sampling looks like is shown on the attached Figure 1.

We will continue to request your cooperation for the following additional tasks:




EXTERIOR EXHAUST PIPING FOR SUB-SLAB DEPRESSURIZATION SYSTEM






