Pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 1341 and M.G.L. c. 21 §§ 26 - 53, notice is given of a 401 Water Quality Certification application for track infrastructure improvements along the Middleborough Secondary, New Bedford Main Line, and Fall River Secondary rail lines as part of the South Coast Rail project. This application has been filed by the Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT), 10 Park Plaza, Boston, MA 02116 for work along the railroad right-of-way in Lakeville, Taunton, Berkley, Freetown, Fall River and New Bedford, Massachusetts. The proposed activities will include placing fill in regulated wetland resource areas in order to update and reconstruct approximately 40 miles of track to extend commuter rail service to New Bedford and Fall River.
