The Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) Division of Water Supply Protection (DWSP) will file a Notice of Intent (NOI) with the Clinton Conservation Commission for proposed aquatic invasive vegetation management at Clamshell Pond in Clinton. The purpose of the project is to remove submersed aquatic invasive vegetation to restore the pond's native plant community and to reduce the potential for the invasive species to be transported to other area water bodies. The NOI will be filed on or about April 30, 2018, and the anticipated hearing date is May 16, 2018.
