## Water Management Act Permit Application Received by the Department of Environmental Protection For the Concord River Basin From the City of Marlborough Water Management Act Permit #9P-2-14-170.01

The City of Marlborough has applied to the Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) for an increase in the Water Management Act authorized withdrawal from Milham Reservoir. The City currently has authorization through a registration and a permit to withdraw 1.77 million gallons per day (MGD). The City is requesting an increase of 0.23 MGD for a total withdrawal volume of 2.00 MGD. The increase will allow the City to reduce the volume of water purchased from the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority. The increased withdrawal will not result in an overall increase in water used by the City. Permits granted in the Concord River Basin are effective through August 31, 2011. Permit holders in the basin will be required to apply for a permit renewal at that time.
