Water Management Act Permit Application Received by the Department of Environmental Protection, Southeast Regional Office, For the Boston Harbor Basin

The Department of Environmental Protection has received a Water Management Act (WMA) Permit application from the Town of Hingham, South Shore Country Club, for withdrawal from the Boston Harbor Basin, Weymouth/Weir River Subwatershed. Comment on the permit application must be submitted by the close of business on Friday, March 28, 2008, to the Department of Environmental Protection, Southeast Regional Office, 20 Riverside Drive, Lakeville, Massachusetts 02347, Attention: Leslie O'Shea, or via e-mail to leslie.o'shea@state.ma.us.

The Town of Hingham operates an 18-hole golf course at the South Shore Country Club. South Shore Country Club has requested a WMA Permit to withdraw on average 0.098 MGD (million gallons per day) for a total of 20.6 MGY (million gallons per year) over a 210-day irrigation season. The withdrawal points are a wellfield at Hole #9 and two unlined surface water sources, Pond #7 at Hole #7 and Pond #14 at Hole #14. The 18-hole course has been in operation since 1952 but did not apply for a WMA Registration, and therefore, now requires a WMA Permit. There is a certified vernal pool on the golf course property.
