In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 111, Sections 150A and 150A 1/2 and the regulations promulgated thereunder, 310 CMR 16.00 "Site Assignment Regulations for Solid Waste Facilities," an application has been filed with the Town of Bourne's Board of Health for modification of the site assignment of a parcel of land for solid waste handling and processing. The land parcel is located at 201 MacArthur Boulevard (Route 28), Bourne, Massachusetts and is adjacent to the site of the current Bourne Sanitary Landfill.

The area under consideration encompasses 25.22 acres, which when combined with the 78 adjacent acres currently site assigned, will total approximately 103 site assigned acres. The waste acceptance rate shall remain as it exists for the current landfill operation with a maximum permitted waste acceptance rate of 825 tons/day.

The Department of Environmental Protection shall receive comments on the proposed site assignment modification for 21 days from the date of the Department's receipt of proof that the public notice requirements have been completed. All comments regarding the assignment of this site should reference the DEP FILE #036-001-B, and be mailed to: David B. The applicant may modify the application for the initial forty (40) days of the review period where such modifications are deemed not to be major modifications. The Department shall issue a Department Report on Suitability within sixty (60) days of the date of the Department's receipt of proof that the public notice requirements have been completed.
