**Nashawtuc Country Club, Concord MA
Concord River Basin
Application for a Water Management Act Permit
Permit #9P-4-14-067.02**

The Nashawtuc Country Club has applied to MassDEP for a Water Management Act (WMA) permit to withdraw water from one bedrock well in the Concord River Basin in Concord, Massachusetts. Nashawtuc Country Club is authorized through WMA Registration no. 31406708 to withdraw up to 0.1 million gallons per day through 2017. The permit application will allow the Nashawtuc Country Club to withdraw water from one new withdrawal location, providing redundancy and operational flexibility. The WMA permit will not increase the average annual withdrawal above the volume authorized in the registration. Nashawtuc Country Club is seeking approval for a maximum pumping rate of 500 gallons per minute (gpm) from proposed Well PW-2, located near the 18th green of the golf course. The approximate location is:
