**Water Management Act Permit Application
Received by the
Department of Environmental Protection
Southeast Regional Office
For the South Coastal Drainage Area**

The Department of Environmental Protection will accept written comments on the Water Management Act (WMA) application filed for permitting in the South Coastal Drainage Area. The permit requested will authorize withdrawals through August 31, 2010, under the Water Management Act, M.G.L. c.21G. Comments should be submitted by May 23, 2003 to the Department of Environmental Protection, Southeast Regional Office, 20 Riverside Drive, Lakeville, Massachusetts 02346, Attention: Jack Hamm.

Pinehills, LLC, Plymouth, has applied for a WMA permit amendment to add four additional withdrawal points to their existing WMA permit #9P3-21-239.03. No additional withdrawal volume is requested above the average daily volume of 0.46 MGD (million gallons per day) currently authorized by permit #9P3-21-239.03. The withdrawal from these four wells will be used for irrigation of common areas. Three of the wells are located at Beaver Dam Road, Plymouth (41° 53' 09" N, 70° 35' 27" W). The fourth well is proposed at Stonebridge Road (41° 53' 17" N, 70° 33' 04" W).
