

Public Notice

Pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 1341 M.G.L. c. 21 S 43, notice is given of an application for 401 Water Quality Certification is pending before the Department of Environmental Protection for the Rehabilitation of the Nahant Beach Reservation, in the Town of Nahant and City of Lynn, Massachusetts. This project is proposed by the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) will reconstruct and/or repair major elements within the Reservation, including the existing roadway, storm drainage and lighting systems, reservation entrance and exit, existing stone revetment, seawalls and boat ramp. Additionally, it is proposed to protect a portion of the existing seawalls with new stone revetment. Mitigation for impacts in the form of saltwater marsh restoration in Rumney Marsh is proposed (in Saugus, MA).
