Cabral Enterprises Inc. & RVC Corporation is proposing to maintain existing structures, accessory use parking and propose stormwater improvements, and permanently moor vessel, the MV Provincia. Contact Steve McKenna.

The Army Corps of Engineers is proposing to maintain dredging of the inner portions of the Boston Harbor Federal Navigation Project. In addition to performing maintenance dredging of the Federal channels it is proposed to remove a rock obstruction in the Main Ship Channel in Boston Harbor as well as six rock outcroppings in the President Roads Anchorage.
