The Department of Environmental Protection will accept written comments on the Water Management Act (WMA) application filed for permitting in the Buzzards Bay Drainage Area. The permit requested would authorize water withdrawals under the Water Management Act, M.G.L. c. 21G from a groundwater source on property adjacent to the Agawam River in Plymouth. The proponent is the Agawam Springs Corporation/ ADM Agawam Development LLC/ Agawam Water Capital LLC. The proposed water system will be operated as a private water supply company.
