Pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 1341 and M.G.L. c. 21 §43, notice is given of a 401 Water Quality Certification Variance Request for the Amesbury Weir Improvement Project located in Amesbury, Massachusetts, by the Town of Amesbury, 62 Friend Street, Amesbury, MA 01913.

This project involves improvements to the Town of Amesbury's weir on the Powwow River, currently in poor condition, located off Newton Road just downstream of the intersection with the Powwow River. The existing weir will be repaired by installing new sheet piling approximately two feet upstream of the existing weir and placing concrete between the two structures for added support. The construction of the weir improvements will result in permanent fill of approximately 280 square feet of Land Under Water in the Powwow River, which is considered an Outstanding Resource Water (ORW). As such, the proposed project does not conform to the regulatory requirements of 314 CMR 9.00 that prohibits discharge of dredged or fill material to ORWs without a variance from the Commissioner.
