**Water Management Act Permit Application  
Received by the  
Department of Environmental Protection  
For the Blackstone River Basin**

The Wilkinsonville Water District has applied to MassDEP for a permit to authorize additional withdrawal volume and to add two groundwater withdrawal locations in the Blackstone River Basin in Sutton, Massachusetts. The Wilkinsonville Water District is currently authorized through a Water Management Act permit (#9P4-2-12-290.01) to withdraw 0.2 million gallons per day (MGD), or 73 million gallons per year through the February 28, 2009. The permit application requests authorization for withdrawal of an additional 0.09 MGD through the end of the permit; February 28, 2009. The permit application also requests authorization to add two new withdrawal locations; bedrock wells located near Woodbury Pond. The Wilkinsonville Water District currently withdraws water from the Hatchery Road Well.
