Water Management Act Permit Application for the **Connecticut River Watershed** Received by the Department of Environmental Protection, Western Region Office **Drinking Water Program** 436 Dwight Street Springfield, MA 01103

The Department of Environmental Protection, Western Regional Office, Drinking Water Program will accept written comments on the Water Management Act permit application recently filed for permitting water withdrawals in the Connecticut River Watershed under the Water Management Act (MGL c.21G). Comments will be accepted until August 31, 2004. A copy of the application is available for review from 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM, every Wednesday at DEP's Drinking Water Program, Western Region Office, 436 Dwight Street, Springfield, MA (413) 784-1100.

Chang Farms has applied for a Water Management Act permit for public water supply withdrawal from the Connecticut River watershed. Change Farms does not have a water management act registration. The permit application states that **Chang Farms** requests an authorized withdrawal of 150,000 gallons per day for the permit duration. The permit would expire on November 30, 2013.

The registered withdrawal points will be 14 wellpoints on the Chang Farm property. The Massachusetts Natural Heritage Atlas, 2000-2001 Edition indicates no Priority Habitats of Rare Species and Estimated Habitats of Rare Wildlife and Vernal Pools¹ in the vicinity of withdrawal points.
