## NOTIFICATION DATE: August 28, 2006

Public notice is hereby given of the application by Walton Realty Trust to perform site restoration and remediation including removal of unauthorized fill, placement of proposed fill and riprap and to license remaining fill and building at 201 Marginal Street in the municipality of Chelsea in and over filled and flowed tidelands of the Chelsea River, within the Chelsea Creek Designated Port Area. The proposed use of the project is to provide shoreline stabilization, and to restore the site for future marine industrial use and is a water dependent project.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways application received by within 30 days subsequent to the "Notification Date". Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c).
