The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has established a **Technical Assistance Grant (TAG)** program that will provide up to \$10,000 to assist citizens in understanding and using technical and scientific information developed during the assessment and cleanup of sites contaminated by oil and/or hazardous materials. Section 14(b) of Massachusetts General Law chapter 21E (the Massachusetts Superfund Law) authorizes these grants.

TAG applications were submitted to DEP in May 2008 and were evaluated using criteria established in Subpart N of the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (310 CMR 40.1450 et seq.). Each grantee will use their funds to hire a technical expert to review site cleanup reports and provide opportunities for the community to participate in the site cleanup process.
