Public notice is hereby given of the Waterways application by First Republic Corporation of America to construct and maintain portions of two residential condominium buildings and associated parking lot, roadways, walkways, and open space in and over Filled Tidelands of the Merrimac River. The proposed project has been determined to be a nonwater-dependent use project. The proponent's consultant is Port Engineering, One Harris Street, Newburyport, MA.

The Department of Environmental Protection, Waterways Regulation Program, with the Newburyport Planning Board as co-chair, will conduct a public hearing on the aforesaid project proposal on Wednesday, October 10, 2007, at 7:00 PM at Newburyport City Hall, 60 Pleasant Street, Newburyport. The purpose of this public hearing is to receive information to be used in making a decision regarding the Waterways License application pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 91. The Waterways Regulation Program welcomes the Planning Board's participation as co-chair of the hearing; however, the subject of the hearing will be confined to the requirements of MGL c. 91 and 310 CMR 9.00.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways application received by October 31, 2007 (Public Comments Deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c).
