Public notice is hereby given of the Waterways application by Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority to Amend License #10163 to replace the culvert under Country Way and widen Bound Brook in the municipality of Scituate in and over flowed Tidelands of the Bound Brook. The proposed project modification has been determined to be water-dependent.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways application received by Thursday, October 26, 2006 (Public Comments Deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c).
