## Acton Water Supply District, Acton, MA Concord River Basin Application for a Water Management Act Permit Amendment Permit #9P4-2-14-002.01

Acton Water Supply District has applied for a Water Management Act permit amendment to withdraw water from a gravel packed well in the Concord River Basin. Acton Water Supply District is authorized through the Water Management Act (WMA) program to withdraw up to 1.94 million gallons per day through August 2011. The permit amendment will allow the District to withdraw water from an additional withdrawal location, providing increased capacity, redundancy and operational flexibility. The WMA amendment will not authorize an increase in the average yearly withdrawal volume. The District is seeking approval for a maximum pumping rate of 360 gallons per minute (0.518 million gallons per day) from Assabet Well No. 3. The proposed well is located on land formerly owned by W.R. Grace & Co. north of the intersection of Route 62 and High St. The approximate location is:
