

NOTICE OF PHASE IV REMEDY IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

**200 Bartlett Street
Northborough, Massachusetts
Bay State Circuits, Inc.
MADEP Site No. 2-0393
Tier 1B Permit No. 84826**

An Addendum to the previously submitted Phase IV – Remedy Implementation Plan (310 CMR 40.0874) for the above site has been developed pursuant to the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (310 CMR 40.1406). The disposal site at 200 Bartlett Street was classified as Tier I and granted a Waste Site Cleanup Permit on July 22, 1994, which was subsequently renewed on October 12, 2001.

The Addendum to the Phase IV – Remedy Implementation Plan describes the modifications to the number and location of the injection and monitoring wells as was previously submitted in the Phase IV – Remedy Implementation Plan. Otherwise the Plan remains as was presented previously, and consists of *in situ* chemical oxidation of chlorinated compounds impacting groundwater at the site. The remedial action consists of the installation and operation of a permanganate oxidation injection system.

M.G.L. c. 21E and the Massachusetts Contingency Plan provide additional opportunities for public notice of and involvement in decisions regarding response actions at disposal sites: 1) The Chief Municipal Official and Board of Health of the community in which the site is located will be notified of major milestones and events, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.1403; and 2) Upon receipt of a petition from ten or more residents of the municipality in which the disposal site is located, or of a municipality potentially affected by a disposal site, a plan for involving the public in decisions regarding response action at the site will be prepared and implemented, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.1405.
