- (a) The project site consists of filled tidelands adjacent to Edgartown Harbor, pursuant to permissions originally granted more than 100 years ago. The project site is a non water dependent site. The structure on site contains a restaurant/bar facility. Currently, a delivery deck and waste management and storage are performed at the proposed addition area. The plan is to enclose the waste management and outside storage areas to improve the vistas from a public way, and to enlarge existing restaurant office space on the second floor. The licensing of two decks constructed earlier to provide outside seating is also part of the project and this Environmental Notification Form.
- (b) The project goal is to provide outside seating and provide a more sightly and manageable waste processing area, and increase the restaurant office space. Alternatives to outside seating goals included extending the decks out towards abutting properties. Impacts would have included obstruction of existing view channels both for abutters and for the public. Moving waste processing and management off site is not an option. No alternative areas exist for waste management on the property. An alternatives analysis included review of off site alternatives, however no suitable location was found and therefore (c) potential mitigation measures were not evaluated. The project itself is anticipated to mitigate existing waste management impacts to the public enjoyment of the streetscape and the vistas enjoyed by the public of the historic Edgartown Harbor.
