The proposed work will occur within the Town's existing 30-foot wide sewer easement. The area is grassed and vegetated. The sewer line was permitted in 1986 and though access was thought to be feasible, during periods the heavy rainfall months and high groundwater access is impossible. The town would like to place down a base of gravel and maintain the access in the future. The 11,710 sf alteration of BVW will be replicated. The replication area will be 11,800 sf.
