

The proposed installation of a septage grit chamber is within a MWRA sewer easement located on a 187.1Ac. parcel of wooded and wetland land owned by the Department of Conservation and Recreation off Neponset Street near the Canton/Norwood Town Line (parcel was formerly the Canton Airport). On the southeast corner of the parcel is a 0.13Ac fenced in gravel area. Licensed septage haulers use this site to dispose of waste into an existing manhole that connects to the MWRA sewer line.

There has been a problem of too much sand and grit from the haulers waste going into the MWRA sewer line from the existing manhole that connects to the MWRA sewer line.

The project involves the installation of a 5,000 gallon 2 compartment tank underground which will connect to the existing sewer manhole which connects to the MWRA sewer line. The tank will be able to hold more grit and that should reduce the discharge of sand and grit into the MWRA sanitary sewer system.
