The Town of Lunenburg is filing a Notice of Project Change (NPC) with MEPA for the Lunenburg CWMP. At the end of Phase I sewer construction (June 2006), the Town halted further phases of construction from their previous SEIR/CWMP. Unforeseen impacts were observed after the completion of Phase I sewer construction and the Town chose to reassess the previous SEIR/CWMP. The recommended plan from the previous SEIR/CWMP consisted of constructing sewer for the identified needs areas and transporting the wastewater to regional wastewater treatment facilities located in Fitchburg and Leominster.

The proposed project change includes areas further identified as needs areas. These are areas that have failing or poorly performing conventional Title 5 systems. The proposed collection system maximizes low pressure sewer systems to minimize wastewater flows, reduce cost, and reduce undesirable growth and development. To help control and regulate infrastructure and onsite wastewater disposal systems, a sewer district management plan and septage management plan are recommended. These plans should be implemented prior to future infrastructure construction. The proposed changes also include a decentralized wastewater treatment facility in the Lake Shirley area and Hickory Hills area. This will allow for highly treated wastewater effluent and help to recharge the respective watershed subbasins.
