The Town has substantially completed Phases 1 and 2 of the Town's sewer expansion program and now plans to proceed with Phases 3 and 4 of the sewer program described in the 2001 CWMP/FEIR. The Supplemental CWMP/NPC recommends a sequenced series of wastewater system improvements presented as Phases 3 and 4 over the next decade in sewer needs areas.

The recommended sewer routes for Phases 3 and 4 are primarily the same as presented in the 2001 CWMP/FEIR with the exception of the addition of two new cross-country reaches in Phase 3 totaling approximately 500 square feet; elimination of three cross-country reaches in Phase 4 based on field observations in 2006 to avoid impacts to areas recently designated as Priority Habitats and Estimated Habitats of Rare Species and wetland areas; and addition of approximately 1 mile of new sewer interceptor route in Methuen to convey flow from the new sewers in Dracut to the Greater Lawrence Sanitary District wastewater treatment plant.
