The existing project site is a asphalt shingle and construction and demolition (C&D) material recycling facility, constructed in 2004 and commenced operations in 2005. The facility received a Determination of Need Permit (DON) from the DEP for the asphalt shingle recycling portion of the facility. DEP and the City of Fitchburg granted Site Assignment for the recycling of C&D material and an Authorization to Operate permit in April 2007. A DEIR was submitted to MEPA for the C&D which was accepted as final.

The project, which is the subject of this application, is to add the processing of Non-Hazardous Liquid Waste (NLHW) which cannot be conducted under the DON or the C&D permit. The existing facility has significant process capacity available.

The total property is about 15 acres with about 4 acres used for recycling. The 4 acres is asphalt paved or under roof. The property is in an industrial park developed by the City of Fitchburg. The existing site is comprised of a dual truck scale and scale house, asphalt paved parking, and a 37,500 process building. New equipment will be used for processing the NHLW. The process simply consists of mixing the liquid waste with a dry material, such as C&D fines, until the resulting mixture can be landfilled. No new construction will be required except the installation of material handling and mixing equipment. The site is served by municipal water and sewer, municipal storm water collection, electric power, and natural gas. No additional utilities will be required.

No alternatives were evaluated because the existing recycling facility has excess unused floor space and this site has received MEPA review and Site Assignment for the C&D material recycling. No new exterior construction is required. Additional equipment to be placed inside the existing building is required.
