The following week, I met with Robert Pyers (Assistant to the Mayor for Economic Development and Marketing) and Nicole Zabko (Greenfield Board of Health) to discuss June 21st meeting. They identified a total of 20 properties, and set a goal of sampling six. Contact information for the property owners was provided to MassDEP by the Town. Additionally, the Town representative reiterated that they wanted to make the first contact with the homeowners. It was agreed that the Town would provide the access agreements for signatures. Mr. Pyers stated that there would be a press release going on that the end of that week and that they hope to have an "Informational Meeting" two weeks following. Mr. Pyers also agreed to the additional sampling of catch basins downgradient from the site. Mr. Pyers believed the sampling activities would begin in mid-July.

MassDEP completed 22 access agreement letters for properties located on Kenwood and Forest Ave. Follow up calls and emails were sent to the Town for information regarding scheduling of the public meeting and approximate date of the sampling event. Response from the Town was limited.

On August 24, 2012, MassDEP emailed Mr. Pyers in regards to submitting the 120-day notification on behalf of the current property owners. Mr. Pyers replied that he was under the impression MassDEP would submit this notification. A separate email was sent by Mr. Pyers for input on a meeting date with the public on either September 11th or 12th. No confirmation was made by the Town on which date they would host the meeting. On September 18, 2012, MassDEP prepared a Notice of Responsibility for Lunt Silversmiths, Inc., RTN: 1-18869. In summary, as of the date of this memorandum, no schedule has been submitted to MassDEP in regards to sampling plans at the abutting properties or public meetings in regards to the release at the Site.
