## Draft Coastal Assessment and Strategy

On February 28, 2006, the Massachusetts Office of Coastal Zone Management (CZM) will host a public meeting to solicit oral and written comments on its Draft Coastal Assessment and Strategy. The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) reviews the Assessment and Strategy for probable grant funding to states to enhance management efforts in the following program areas: Wetlands, Public Access, Coastal Hazards, Cumulative and Secondary Impacts, Energy and Government Facility Siting, Marine Debris, Ocean Resources, Special Area Management, and Aquaculture. State Coastal Zone Management Programs are required to review progress in these areas every five years, and update and develop new strategies as appropriate.
