The Commonwealth of Massachusetts' Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance ("DCAM"), (formerly known as the Division of Capital Planning and Operations) hereby gives notice that: (1) pursuant to section 6 of Chapter 676 of the Special Acts of 1985, a public meeting will be held by the Department of Conservation and Recreation ("DCR"), formerly the Department of Environmental Management ("DEM"), to review and accept comments on amendments to the "Greylock Center Master Plan, Revised February, 1996"; and (2) pursuant to Section 40F1/2 of Chapter 7 of the General Laws, a public hearing will be held to discuss any reuse restrictions applicable to 1,063 acres of the "Lands" as defined in Chapter 676 (hereinafter "Greylock Glen") and which may be incorporated within the leasehold disposition of all or a portion Grevlock Glen. Greylock Glen is located easterly of the Mount Greylock State Reservation, on and off of Gould Road, Thiel Road and West Mountain Road in the Town of Adams.

Chapter 676 authorizes Greylock Glen, currently under the care and control of the DCR's Division of State Parks and Recreation, to be leased for regional economic and recreational development purposes, as the Commissioner of DCR deems appropriate to implement the Greylock Center Master Plan Revised February, 1996 (and as to be amended) and the purposes of Chapter 676.

Copies of the amended Greylock Center Master Plan will be available for viewing at the Adams Public Library and for general public viewing on the Commonwealth's web site (Mass.gov) under the Operational Services Division's web page under COMM-PASS (HTTP://WWW.COMM-PASS.COM).

The public meeting/hearing will be held on March 2, 2004 at 6:30 PM in the Miller Annex Meeting Room, Adams Public Library, 92 Park Street, Adams, Massachusetts.
