**Water Management Act Permit Application Received by the  
Department of Environmental Protection, Southeast Regional Office,  
For the South Coastal Basin**

The Town of Pembroke has filed an application for a Water Management Act (WMA) Permit to increase the Town's authorized withdrawal volume. Comment on the permit application must be submitted by close of business on Wednesday, **April 16, 2008**, to the Department of Environmental Protection, Southeast Regional Office, 20 Riverside Drive, Lakeville, Massachusetts 02347, Attention: Leslie O'Shea, or via e-mail to [leslie.o'shea@state.ma.us](mailto:leslie.o'shea@state.ma.us).

The Town of Pembroke (Pembroke) is currently authorized to withdraw an average daily volume of 0.99 MGD (million gallons per day) under WMA Registration #421231.01 and 0.27 MGD under WMA Permit #9P421231.01, for a total average daily withdrawal volume of 1.26 MGD, or 459.90 MGY (million gallons per year). Pembroke is requesting to increase the WMA authorized volume from 1.26 MGD to 1.665 MGD (or 607.725 MGY) through the permit end date of August 31, 2010. Pembroke withdraws water from five authorized withdrawal points; no additional withdrawal points are requested by this permit application.
