**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
TOWN OF SHREWSBURY**

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts' Division of Capital Asset Management hereby gives notice that, pursuant to Chapter 463 of the Acts of 1990, Sections 40F1/2 and 40I of Chapter Seven of the Massachusetts General Laws, a public hearing shall be conducted to disclose the conditions and reasons for the disposition of two (2) parcels of state owned land consisting of 102.35± acres which have been determined to be surplus to current and foreseeable state needs and is available for other uses. The property is located in Shrewsbury at the former Grafton State Hospital. The property, which was acquired by the Department of Mental Health for the purpose of care of mental health patients, is currently vacant land. The proposed use for the property is for economic development including biotechnology, light manufacturing, research and development, or other uses as established by the master plan.

The hearing shall be conducted on Monday April 28, 2003 at 7:00 p.m., in Conference Room B, at the Richard D. Carney Municipal Offices, 100 Maple Avenue, Shrewsbury, Massachusetts.
