Public notice is hereby given of the Waterways application by Bayside Marketing Systems, Inc. d/b/a Jake’s Seafood Restaurant and the Town of Hull (co-applicant), hereinafter to be referred to as “Jake’s Restaurant” to construct and maintain a proposed addition, stormwater structures, and a bottom anchored float, and maintain authorized fill, the existing building, and all current uses at 50 George Washington Boulevard in the municipality of Hull in and over Flowed and Filled Commonwealth Tidelands of the Weir River. The project contains Water-Dependent and Nonwater-Dependent uses and therefore the entire project has been determined to be Nonwater-Dependent.

The Department of Environmental Protection, Waterways Regulation Program, will conduct a public hearing on the aforesaid project proposal on Wednesday May 28, 2008, at 10:00 am in the Selectmen’s Meeting Room at the Town Hall, 253 Atlantic Avenue, Hull, MA 02045. The Department will conduct this public hearing in order to receive information to be used in its decision on whether to grant a Waterways License pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 91.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways application received by June 20, 2008 (Public Comments Deadline – includes the MEPA Environmental Monitor notice). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c).
