On June 9, 2005, the Water Resources Commission will be discussing a proposal to designate the Weir River (part of the Boston Harbor river basin) as a highly stressed basin. The discussion will focus on information presented by the Weir River Watershed Association and the Riverways Program in the Department of Fish and Game.
