NOTICE is hereby given on behalf of Narragansett Electric Company ("Narragansett") of a settlement relative to alleged releases of oil and/or hazardous materials at certain property consisting of approximately 24 acres located at and adjacent to Brown Street, Mendon Road and Robinson Street, Attleboro, Massachusetts and approximately 1.5 acres located near Lawn Street, Attleboro, Massachusetts (Lot 95A on the City of Attleboro's Assessor Map) ("the Site"). All portions of the Site have reached a regulatory cleanup endpoint in the form of either a No Further Action or a Response Action Outcome pursuant to the Massachusetts Oil and Hazardous Material Release Prevention and Response Act, M.G.L. c. 21E, as amended, and the regulations promulgated thereunder as the Massachusetts Contingency Plan, 310 CMR 40.0000 et seq.

Narragansett has resolved the claims of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in a Consent Decree regarding the Site. The Consent Decree requires Narragansett to reimburse the Commonwealth for response costs incurred at the Site. As of the effective date of the Consent Decree, Narragansett shall be entitled to protection from claims brought pursuant to M.G.L. c. 21E for contribution, cost recovery or equitable share regarding matters addressed in the Consent Decree, pursuant to Section 3A(j)(3) of M.G.L. c. 21E.
