**ANNOUNCEMENT ON "LID SUBDIVISION DEMONSTRATION PROJECT" FOR THE IPSWICH RIVER WATERSHED**

As part of a larger project funded by the USEPA Targeted Watersheds Program, the Department of Conservation & Recreation (DCR) will be offering up to \$75,000 to help support a subdivision development project, located in the Ipswich River watershed, to incorporate low-impact development (LID) principles as the basis of its design. The project must be constructed no later than September 2007.

DCR expects to post a Request for Responses (RFR) for this project in August 2005 in the Commonwealth's Comm-PASS solicitation system (<http://www.comm-pass.com/>).
