Public Notice is hereby given of the application by Bio-Microbics, Inc. and Smith & Loveless, Inc. to the Department of Environmental Protection requesting Certification for Provisional Use of FAST® for Design Flows - 2000 gpd to less than 10,000 gpd pursuant to 310 CMR 15.286 of Title 5. This provision of Title 5 describes the approval process for Provisional Use of innovative/ alternative technologies for the treatment and subsurface disposal of sewage from facilities with design flows of less than 10,000 gallons per day.

The application proposes this as equivalent technology for the following provision in Title 5:

The FAST® technology is proposed to provide nitrogen removal in accordance with 310 CMR 15.202. This treatment technology is proposed to be at least equivalent to a recirculating sand filter and to be capable of treating wastewater to produce an effluent with total nitrogen concentration less than 25 milligrams per liter (mg/L) for multi-unit residential and non-residential facilities.

The Department welcomes any interested parties to provide any relevant information concerning the performance of this technology to be considered in the review process. The Department will consider all data and written comments submitted within 21 days after the publication of this notice in order to decide whether to grant approval pursuant to 310 CMR 15.000.
