2005 TRANSIT COMMITMENTS PROJECT UPDATE AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC REVIEW

Pursuant to the Executive Office of Transportation and Construction (EOTC) and Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Administrative Consent Order (ACO) regarding Mass Transit Commitments (dated September 1, 2000), EOTC recently filed the 2005 Project Update and Project Schedule. This documents provides a description and a status of all projects listed in the Transit Commitments ACO as well as the two ACO Amendments.
