Public notice is hereby given of the application by Yankee Marine Real Estate Trust to repair and reconstruct marine-related structures at the Fitzgerald Shipyard including rebuilding a marine railway, removing dilapidated wharf sections and piles, reconstructing seawall sections, rebuilding piers and maintaining existing piers at 1 Winnisimmet St. in the municipality of Chelsea in and over flowed tidelands of the Chelsea Creek DPA. The proposed use of the project is to provide a commercial boat building, repair and servicing facility and is a water dependent project.


The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways application received by within 30 days subsequent to the "Notification Date". Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c).
