NOTICE OF A REMEDY IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

FORMER ROME BUILDING PRODUCTS. 744 MILLBURY STREET WORCESTER, MA DEP SITE 2-0989

A Remedy Implementation Plan (310 CMR 40.0874) has been developed for this site pursuant to the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (310 CMR 40.1406). This disposal site was classified as a Tier I in April 2004 and was subsequently granted a Waste Site Cleanup Permit by DEP.

The Remedy Implementation Plan proposes the following measures to respond to a release of oil and/or hazardous materials at this disposal site:

 Response actions will be implemented at the Site as part of the re-construction of the Route 146 Corridor. Impacted soils at the Site will be covered either by roadway construction or the placement of marker layer and a minimum of three feet of clean fill.

M.G.L. c. 21E and the Massachusetts Contingency Plan provide additional opportunities for public notice and involvement in decisions regarding response actions at disposal sites: 1) The Chief Municipal Officer and Board of Health of the community in which the site is located will be notified of major milestones and events, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.1403; and 2) Upon receipt of a petition of ten or more residents of the municipality in which the disposal site is located, or of a municipality potentially affected by the disposal site, a plan for involving the public in decisions regarding response actions at the site will be prepared and implemented, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.1405.
