

NOTICE OF A REMEDY IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

A **Remedy Implementation Plan** (310 CMR 40.0874) has been developed for the above site pursuant to the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (310 CMR 40.1406). This disposal site was classified as Tier I on **August 14, 2001** and granted a Waste Site Cleanup Permit on **February 13, 2002**.

The **Remedy Implementation Plan** proposes the following measures to respond to a release of oil and/or hazardous material at this disposal site:

The remedial actions include five major components: excavation of the MSS-02 hot spot soils, sediment removal from the upstream swale, construction of a capping system, imposition of AULs, and subsequent performance monitoring of the cap and attenuation processes for sediments and groundwater.

M.G.L. c. 21E and the Massachusetts Contingency Plan provide additional opportunities for public notice of and involvement in decisions regarding response actions at disposal sites: 1) The Chief Municipal Official and Board of Health of the community in which the site is located will be notified of major milestones and events, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.1403; and 2) Upon receipt of a petition from ten or more residents of the municipality in which the disposal site is located, or of a municipality potentially affected by a disposal site, a plan for involving the public in decisions regarding response actions at the site will be prepared and implemented, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.1405.
