Public notice is hereby given of the Waterways application by the Towns of Edgartown and Oak Bluffs to dredge approximately 200,000 cubic yards of maintenance and improvement dredging under a <u>Ten-Year Comprehensive Dredge and Beach Nourishment Plan</u>, in the areas of Cape Pogue, Edgartown Harbor, Edgartown Great Pond and Sengekontacket Pond in the municipalities of Edgartown and Oak Bluffs with the material to be used as beach nourishment. The proposed project has been determined to be water-dependent.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways application received by within 15 days subsequent to the "Notification Date". Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c).
