In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 111, Sections 150A and 150A 1/2 and the regulations promulgated thereunder, 310 CMR 16.00 "Site Assignment Regulations for Solid Waste Facilities," an application has been filed with the Abington Board of Health for site assignment of a parcel of land for a solid waste transfer station, located at 1477 Bedford Street, Abington, MA, 02351.

The area under consideration is 6.9 acres and will be used for a transfer station that will accept construction and demolition material waste at a maximum of 600 tons/day. The proponent is Abington Transfer Station LLC, 1477 Bedford Street, Abington, MA 02351.

The Department of Environmental Protection shall receive comments on the proposed facility site for 21 days from the date of the Department's receipt of proof that the public notice requirements have been completed. All comments regarding the assignment of this site should reference the DEP FILE # 001-001-C, and be mailed to: David B. The applicant may modify the application for the initial forty (40) days of the review period where such modifications are deemed not to be major modifications. The Department shall issue a Department Report on Suitability within sixty (60) days of the date of the Department's receipt of proof that the public notice requirements have been completed.
