Public notice is hereby given of the Waterways application by 2 Main Street, LLC to construct and maintain a proposed fixed timber pier and 3<sup>rd</sup> floor addition to an existing restaurant, retail shops, and associated patio and waterfront walkways, at 2 Main Street in the municipality of Edgartown in and over Filled and Flowed Tidelands of Edgartown Harbor. The proposed project has been determined to be nonwater-dependent.

The Department of Environmental Protection, Waterways Regulation Program, will conduct a public hearing on the aforesaid project proposal on Wednesday, October 18, 2006, at 12:00 pm in the Fred B. Morgan, Jr. Meeting Room at the Town Hall, 70 Main Street, Edgartown, MA. The Department will conduct this public hearing in order to receive information to be used in its decision on whether to grant a Waterways License pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 91.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways application received by November 9, 2006 (Public Comments Deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c).
