Public notice is hereby given of the application Amerada Hess Corporation to renovate an existing gas station and construct a new convenience store on the filled tidelands of the South River. This is a nonwater-dependent use project.

The Department of Environmental Protection, Waterways Regulation Program, will conduct a public hearing on the aforesaid project proposal on Tuesday, November 12, 2002, at 6:00 p.m. in Room 313, 3rd Floor, Salem City Hall Annex, 120 Washington Street, Salem. The Department will conduct this public hearing in order to receive information to be used in its decision on whether to grant a Waterways License pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 91.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways application received by December 3, 2002 (Public Comments Deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c).
