Public notice is hereby given of the Waterways application by Aquaria Water LLC, (desalination plant), to amend License No. 11411 to modify and construct a drinking water intake structure, submerged retaining wall and deflector boom at 170 Aquaria Drive, Dighton in the municipality of Dighton in and over filled and flowed tidelands of Taunton River. The proposed project has been determined to be water-dependent.


The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways application received by within 30 days subsequent to the "Notification Date". Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c).
