PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP or the Department), acting in accordance with the provisions of M.G.L. chapter 111, Section 142A through 142E, offers for public comment the following draft CO<sub>2</sub> Budget Trading Program Emission Control Plan approval issued pursuant to regulation 310 CMR 7.70, the Massachusetts CO<sub>2</sub> Budget Trading Program.

The draft Emission Control Plan approval for Stony Brook Energy Center is being issued in accordance with 310 CMR 7.70. MassDEP has determined that Units 001, 002, 003, 004, and 005 at this facility are subject to the CO<sub>2</sub> Budget Trading Program. As such, the draft Emission Control Plan approval sets forth the methodologies for monitoring the CO<sub>2</sub> mass emissions and the net electric generation from the applicable units. The purpose of the Emission Control Plan is to codify these monitoring methodologies under the state CO<sub>2</sub> Budget Trading Program regulation.
