The land is under the care and control of the Department of Mental Health and is currently unoccupied, with former hospital improvements boarded up. The land has been determined to be surplus to current and foreseeable direct public uses and is available for sale, lease (not to exceed ninety-nine years), and/or transfer to a public agency for a public purpose.
