Receipt of a Request for Determination of Insignificance Under the Interbasin Transfer Act MGL Chapter 21 Sections 8b-8d

On June 25, 2002, the Massachusetts Water Resources Commission (WRC) received the additional information needed to evaluate a request for determination of insignificance under the Interbasin Transfer Act (M.G.L. Chapter 21 §§ 8B-8D) from the former Sager Electronics and the J.M. Perrone Co., Inc. for a proposed sewer connection to the MWRA wastewater system. The properties are located at 60 Research Road and 105 Research Road in the town of Hingham and receives water supply from the Weymouth and Weir subbasin of the Boston Harbor basin. Wastewater will be discharged to the Massachusetts Coastal basin. It is expected that a maximum of 4,500 gallons per day of wastewater will be transferred on an annualized basis.

It is expected that the WRC will discuss this request at its August 8, 2002 meeting. This meeting will be held at 1 PM at the Mashpee Water District, 10-B Cape Drive, Mashpee, MA. A vote to approve or deny the request is anticipated for the September 12, 2002 WRC meeting. This meeting will be held at 1 PM in Conference Room 1102 on the 11th floor of the Environmental Protection Agency, 1 Congress Street in Boston.
