

This project is to construct a gravel driveway through a bordering vegetated wetland in order to access a large upland located behind the BVW. This driveway will provide a secondary access to the house located on an adjacent lot, and allow the rear of the property to be used for agricultural purposes such as crop growing, composting, or a greenhouse. It is proposed to replicate 8,943 sq.ft. of wetland with a 14,000 sq.ft. area contiguous to the existing BVW.
