The existing project site is a new asphalt shingle recycling facility, constructed in 2004 and commenced operations in 2005. The facility received a Determination of Need Permit from the DEP. The project, which is the subject of this application, is to add the processing of Construction and Demolition (C&D) Debris which cannot be conducted under the DON. The existing facility has significant process capacity available.

The total property is about 15 acres with about 4 acres used for recycling. The 4 acres is asphalt paved or under roof. The property is in an industrial park developed by the City of Fitchburg. The site is comprised of a dual truck scale and scale house, asphalt paved parking, and a 37,500 process building. The existing equipment will be used for C&D materials separation/recycling. No new construction will be required. The site is served by municipal water and sewer, municipal storm water collection, electric power, and natural gas. No additional utilities will be required.

No alternatives were evaluated because the proposed project is simply to process different but similar materials (roof tear offs vs. C&D) at the existing recycling facility. No new construction is required. No modification to existing equipment or structures is required.
